INSTALLATION

- 1. Begin by locating the roll pin on both the master cylinder and the slave cylinder.
- 2. Remove the pins to allow the release of the hose assembly fittings.
- 3. Install the new Russell fittings into the master cylinder and slave cylinder using the roll pins to keep the fittings retained.
- 4. Install the new Russell hose assembly to the previously installed Russell fittings. Avoid installing the Russell hose in a twisted position or near any moving parts to prevent any damage to the Russell hose assembly.
- 5. Once the new Russell hose is installed, the system must be bled to remove any possible air from the line.
- 6. We recommend that you remove the master cylinder cap and slowly depress the clutch. After several depressions, the hose assembly should be bled and the slave cylinder should be operational.
- 7. Check the system for leaks and refill the master cylinder as necessary.
